Inclement Weather Procedures for Bus Transportation

Attention PCA Parents! Please read this document carefully so that you understand our winter weather procedures if PCA needs to delay or cancel school due to inclement weather. In addition, parents will need to follow their school district of residence for their delays or cancellations. Please contact our office if you have any questions.

PCA will send out a Parent Alert if our school is delayed or closed. We will also notify the following news stations: WPXI, KDKA, WTAE, Butler Media Group, WBUT (1050AM), WLER (97.75 FM), WISR (680 AM), and KDKA radio. Additionally, we will post on Facebook and Instagram.

If PCA is delayed/canceled and your school district is delayed/canceled:

If PCA is delayed and your school district is delayed, your busing will also be delayed and your child will arrive at school at the delayed time. If your district is closed and PCA is closed, there will be no busing.

If PCA is NOT delayed and your school district is delayed:

If PCA is NOT delayed and your school district is delayed, your bus will arrive to PCA at your district's delayed time. Your child will not be considered tardy. You also have the option to drive your child to school at the regular scheduled time, if you'd like to do so.

If PCA is NOT canceled and your school district is canceled:

If PCA is NOT canceled and your school district is canceled, your child will have NO busing. Your child will not be considered absent if this should occur. You also have the option of driving your child to and from school, if you'd like to do so. **REMINDER: Your child will have no busing so you must pick them up in pickup line.**

If PCA is delayed and your school district is NOT delayed:

If PCA is delayed and your district is NOT delayed, please be aware of the following:

- Butler, South Butler, Slippery Rock and Seneca Valley School Districts will follow PCA's delay and send busses at the delayed time.
- Mars and Pine Richland School Districts **WILL NOT** follow PCA's delay. Parents have the option of driving students to school at the delayed time or keeping students home for the day. Students who do not attend on delay days because of bus transportation will not be counted as absent.
